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## **“ME AND MY PAL” DRAWING CONTEST 2010-2011**

The “Me and My Pal” drawing contest was created by the Franklin County Auditor’s Office to help promote responsible pet care and ownership. One of the responsibilities of the Auditor is to license all dogs in the county. We licensed over 100,000 dogs last year and issued 20 licensed kennels (which is 162 more dogs). Licensing your dog is required by the State of Ohio. The license is an assigned I.D. Number that identifies you as the owner should the dog get lost or separated from you.

### **CONTEST RULES:**

1. There are two categories, dog owners and non-dog owners. There will be one winner from each grade level (K-6) per category. An overall contest winner will be selected from among the seven winners in the dog owner category.
2. All dogs must be currently licensed and immunized. (This applies to both dog owner and non-dog owner categories).
3. Please be sure that the picture includes you and the dog(s).
4. All entries must be received in the Franklin County Auditor’s Office by 5:00 p.m., Friday, November 19, 2010. Entries postmarked after that date will not be eligible.
5. Employees of the Franklin County Auditor’s Office, Franklin County Animal Control, the Capital Area Humane Society, and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the contest.
6. The judges will be a panel of Franklin County art teachers. All decisions of the judges are final.
7. The overall contest winner chosen from the dog owner category will receive the first dog tag issued for 2011, in addition to several other prizes that are being confirmed.
8. The other six winners from the dog owner category will receive the next six dog tags issued for 2011, along with other prizes that are being confirmed.
9. Please use 8 1/2 “by 11” white bond paper, with pencil, pen, markers or paint. All entries will become the property of the Franklin County Auditor.
10. Winners will be contacted by November 29, 2010.
11. The overall winner’s drawing will be used as a display at all locations where dog licenses are sold throughout Franklin County.
