Franklin County Auditor has an immediate opening as Deputy County Auditor, Director of the Franklin County Data Center.

TITLE : Deputy Auditor, Director Franklin County Data Processing Center

Primary Responsibilities:

This Position is responsible for Providing Centralized Data Processing Services in support of all Franklin County Agencies under authority of the Automatic Data Processing Board as established by ORC 307.842. Coordinates strategic long-term planning, implementation, and operation of countywide information systems. Organizes, directs, controls and defines goals and objectives for the efficient management and operation of the County Data Center. Recommends and leads technology initiatives and ensures effective, efficient and secure operation of the Franklin County Data Network (FCDN). Responsible for overall communication and coordination of Information Technology (IT) issues with County Agencies. Advises and assists County Agencies with development of their Strategic Business Plans, Information Technology (IT) plans, and IT budgets. Assists the OMB in implementing fiscal controls on IT products and services. Ensures consistency and compliance with County policies and strategies.

QUALIFICATIONS:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Strong communication and facilitation skills. Must be able to work with other IT directors and recommend solutions based on insight into what is being requested and how budgeted dollars are best used. Must be knowledgeable in providing IT services and solutions through a service provider/bureau concept delivery model, while providing enterprise wide solutions, all within the ORC 307.842 through 307.846 requirements.
- Strong and decisive leadership; Effective strategic planning skills; Knowledge of the principles and practices of information management/telecommunication technology and systems; Extensive knowledge of technology environments, including IT architecture, configuration control, telecommunications, LAN/WAN, application development, databases, web development, and enterprise document management; Strong project management skills; Relationship building skills.
Ability to manage senior-level staff; coherently and professionally communicate ideas to diverse groups; originate meaningful and accurate documents involving

complex subject matter; evaluate multiple variables and determine specific course of action; foster environment of morale and cooperation; lead, develop, implement and operate technology solutions in a complex systems and operational environment.
