STINZIANO TO HOLD FIRST COMMUNITY HOURS AS FRANKLIN COUNTY AUDITOR

COLUMBUS, Ohio – Franklin County Auditor Michael Stinziano will hold his first Community Hours meetings this week, continuing a practice that he has done as an elected official for more than a decade.
