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## AUDITOR STINZIANO TO HOLD EXPANDED BOARD OF REVISION INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS

COLUMBUS, Ohio – Franklin County Auditor Michael Stinziano announced an expanded round of Board of Revision informational meetings this month to help homeowners challenge their property value assessments.

The meetings, which will be held throughout Franklin County, assist homeowners with the process of appealing the property value assessments that have been made by the Auditor's office.

Those property values are used to calculate property tax assessments. The Board of Revision, which is comprised of Auditor Stinziano, the county treasurer, and the president of the board of county commissioners, holds hearings where property values are challenged and can adjust the values. The deadline to appeal property value assessments is April 1.

"The Franklin County Auditor's office wants to make it easy to understand and appeal property value assessments. We will offer outstanding public service that will make it easier for homeowners to remain in their homes," Stinziano said.
