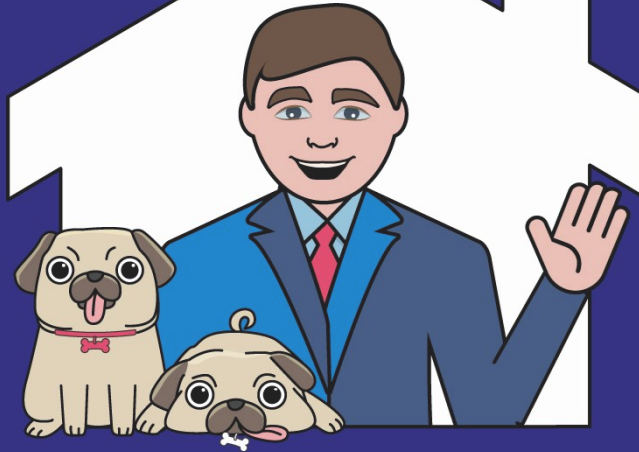

## "Me and My Pal" Drawing Contest Rules

-  Drawing must include the artist and the dog(s).
-  For drawings, please use 8.5 x 11 white bond paper, with pencil, pen, markers or paint. All entries will become the property of the Franklin County Auditor for 6 months, and then will be returned to the contestant.
-  All entries must be received by the Franklin County Auditor's Office on November 23, 2020
-  A panel will be selected to judge the submitted entries.
-  The overall contest winner will receive a gift dog tag issued for 2020, have their drawing featured in the 2020 dog licensing promotional materials and posted to the Auditor's social media sites.
-  The overall winner's drawing will be used as a display at locations where dog licenses are sold throughout Franklin County Ohio. All winners will receive an award certificate and commemorative photo taken with the Auditor.
-  All K-6 grade level students enrolled in a school within Franklin County, Ohio are eligible. The entry must be the drawing of the qualifying artist. Employees of the Franklin County Auditor's Office, Franklin County Dog Shelter and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the contest.

A virtual ceremony to celebrate and award the winners will be held Saturday, December. Winners will be contacted by December 1, 2020.

The "Me and My Pal" drawing contest is sponsored by the Franklin County Auditor's Office to help promote responsible pet care and ownership. One of the responsibilities of the Auditor is to license all dogs in the county. The license identifies you as your dog's owner should your dog get lost or separated from you, and is required by state law. All dogs must be currently licensed and immunized.
